Purpose of data processing and consequences of not providing personal data: The data is processed for the purpose of providing information to the public health department or the local police authority pursuant to §§ 16, 25 IfSG and insofar for the purpose of tracing possible transmission pathways in connection with Covid-19. Any other use of the data is prohibited. The University must exclude persons who refuse to provide their contact details from visiting or using the facility or from participating in the event.

Data categories: Contact details of those present, especially visitors, users and participants.

Lawfulness of processing: Art. 6 Section. 1 Subsection. 1 lit. c, Section. 3 GDPR i.V.m. §§ 6, 14 S. 1 No. 1, 10 Section. 1 S. 1 CoronaVO.

Storage duration or criteria for determining duration: The data is stored for a period of four weeks and then deleted or destroyed.

Categories of recipients: Internal recipients of the data are exclusively those employees of the University of Freiburg who process the data in the course of their duties. Upon request, the data collected here must be transferred to the competent authority if this is necessary for tracing possible transmission pathways.

Your rights as a data subject:

- You have the right to obtain information from the University of Freiburg about the data stored about you and/or to have incorrectly stored data corrected.
- In addition, you have the right to have your data deleted or to restrict processing, as well as the right to object to processing.
- You have the right to complain to a supervisory authority if you believe that the processing of personal
 data concerning you is in violation of legal provisions. Such a supervisory authority is for example the
